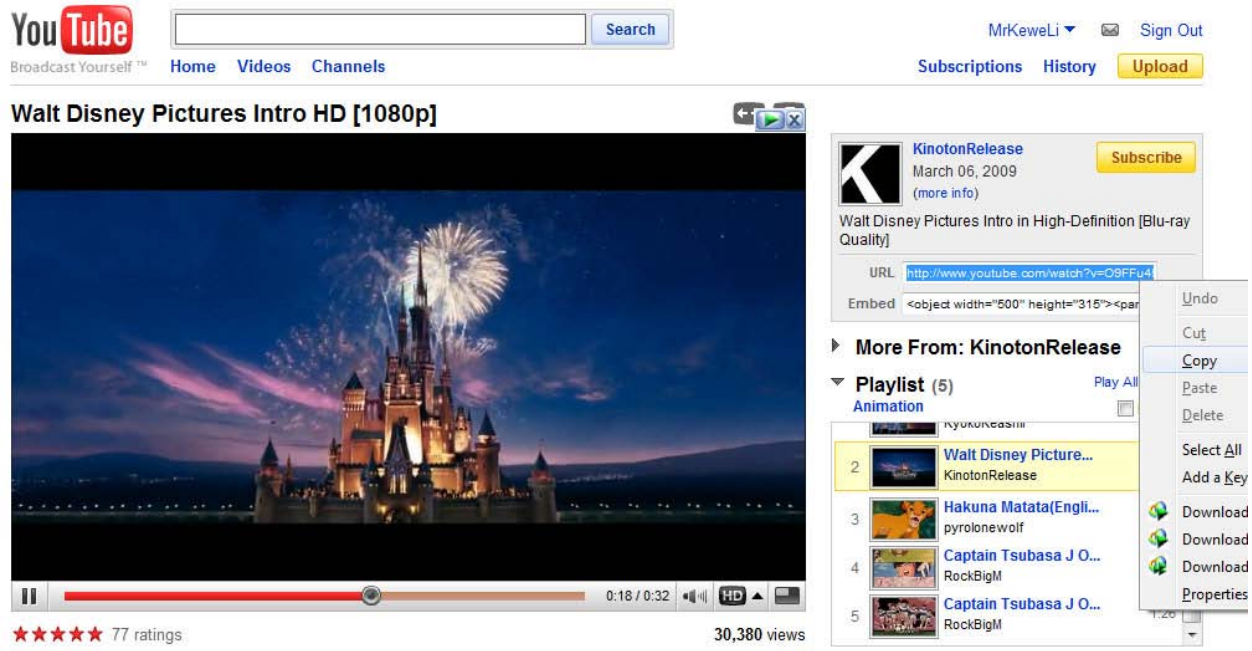


Obtaining YouTube Videos

YouTube videos are often encoded in a flash video format (.FLV). However, if a high definition version was uploaded (generally 720p or 1080p .MP4 format), that original video can be retrieved. Here is a simple guide:

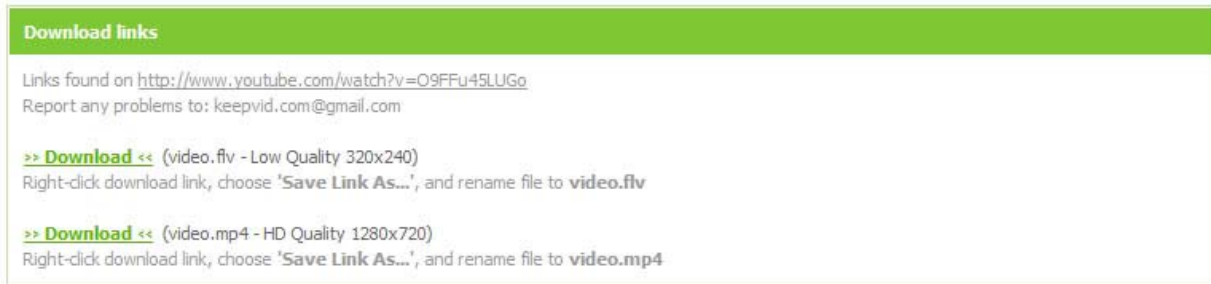
1. Copy the URL of the YouTube video.



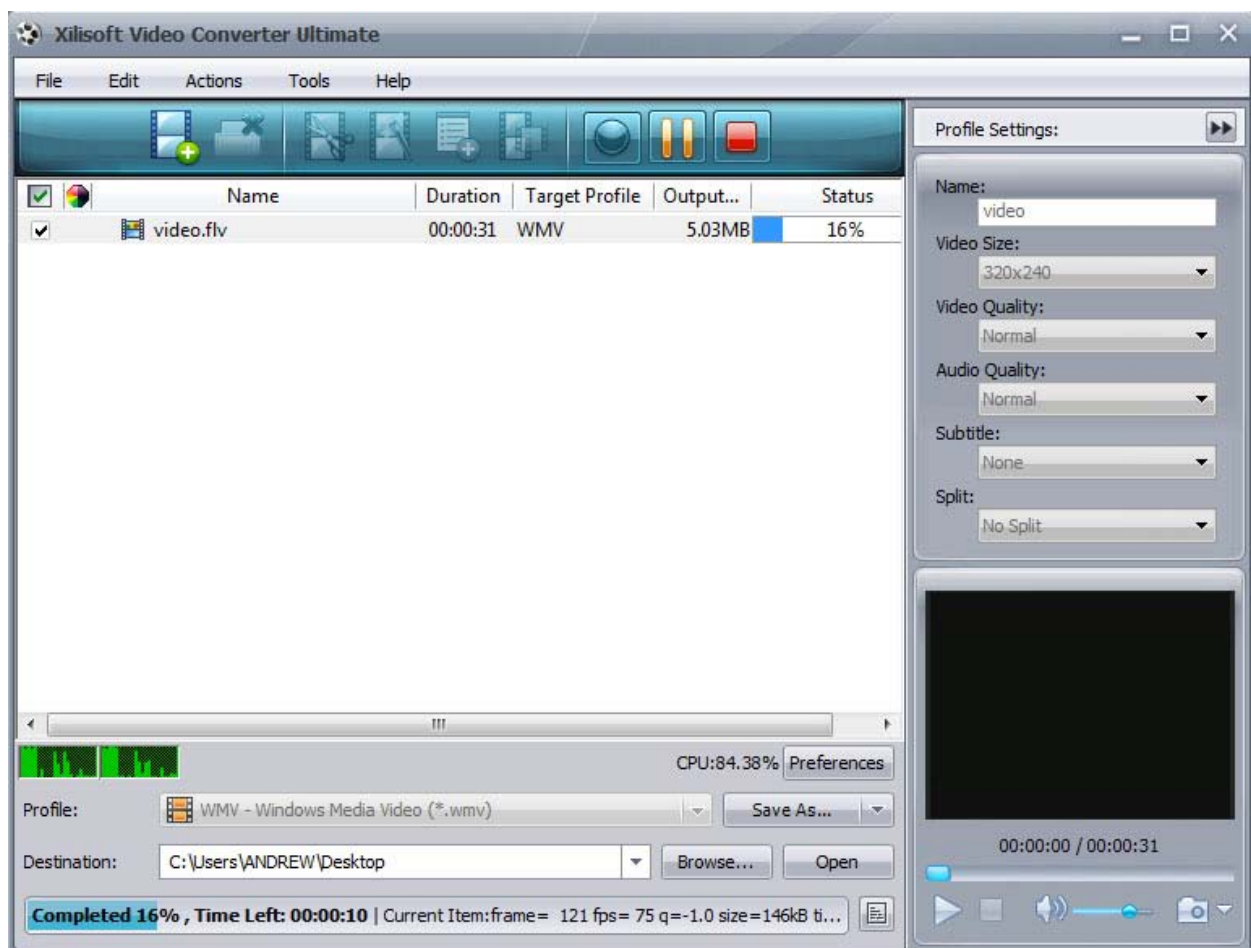
2. Go to <http://keepvid.com>, paste the link, and then click download.
* Note: there are different sites and softwares you can use



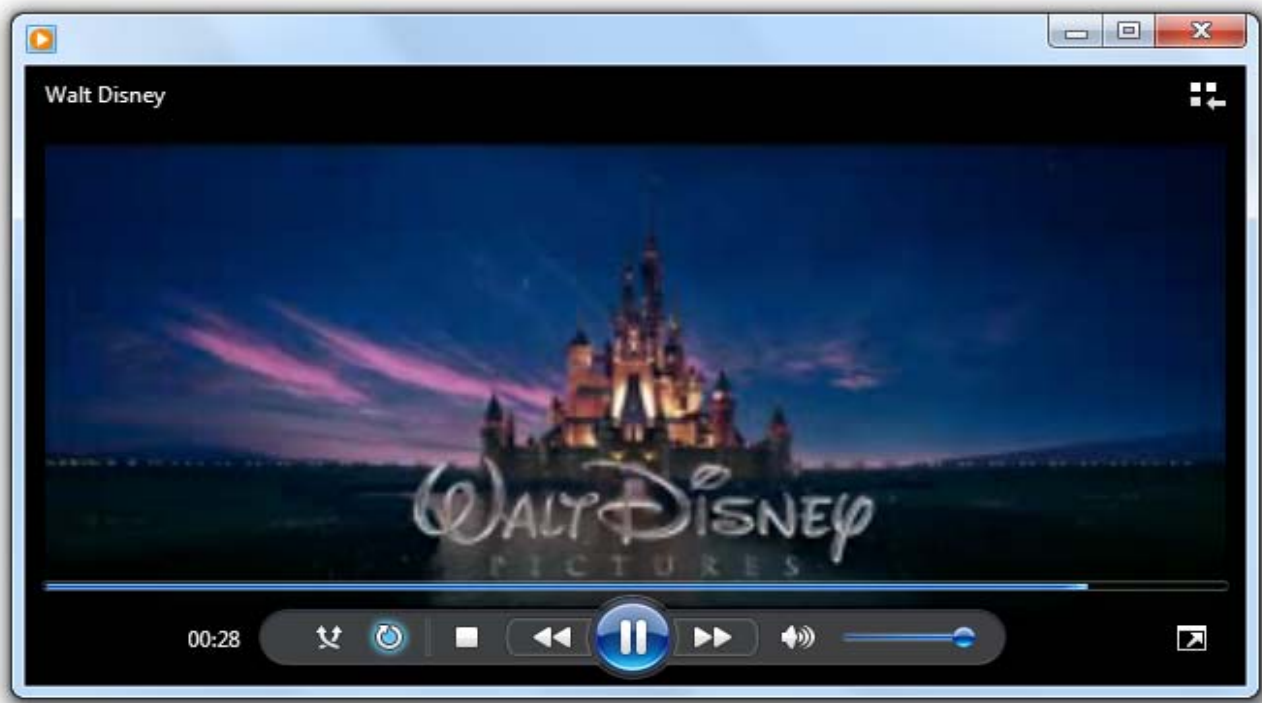
- Right click the download link, and then choose “save link as” or “save target as”. This will either download the .FLV or .MP4 depending on your choice and its availability.



- Use a video converter which supports .FLV files to convert your video into a desired format.
* Note: you may skip this step if you already have the .MP4 version or would like to use the .FLV version



5. You can now watch the converted video directly off your computer.



Or alternatively, the HD version if available.
